TEN-X WIND READER TROPHY MATCH OCTOBER 19, 2025

Sponsor: Rio Salado Sportsman's Club High Power Division

Eligibility: Open both members and non-members of Rio Salado Sportsman's Club

Entry Fee: \$60 for adults, juniors under 18 free -

Registration: Registration at <https://practiscore.com> -- search Rio Salado Ten-X for upcoming match.

Entries: Entries limited to 45 shooters by advance registration. Entries will be accepted on first come/first serve basis until all 15 firing positions are filled with three shooters per firing point. While NRA and Rio Salado Sportsman's Club membership is encouraged, it is *not* required to compete in this match. No refunds will be granted after the match commences.

Location: Rio Salado Sportsman's Club, 3960 N. Usery Pass Road, Mesa, AZ. Maps and directions, can be found on the club's website - www.rsscraz.com.

Safety Rules: NRA-approved empty indicators (ECIs) must be in rifles at all times, except during live fire periods. ECIs can be purchased from the HP Division for \$1 each. Safety glasses and ear protection must be worn by all competitors as well as spectators – no exceptions. No glass bottles and alcoholic beverages. No smoking allowed on the line.

Squadding: Squadding will be announced beginning at 8:00 a.m.

Divisions: Any Rifle-Any Sights (NRA rule 3.2); Service Rifle (Rule 3.1.6); F-TR defined as a .308 or .223 with a bipod; and F-Class Open (Rule Section 23). Rules prohibit muzzle brakes. Competitors with rifles that do not meet the aforementioned divisions compete in the NRA Non Compliant division.

Scoring: The match will be shot on Shot-Marker electronic targets, a limited quantity of Amazon Fire tablets will be provided for shot tracking / scoring purposes, so participants are encouraged to bring their own tablet or smartphone.

Ammunition: Competitors will need a minimum of 70 rounds for record shots comprising sighters and shots for record. Competitors should bring extra ammunition for bad rounds, or electronic target missed shots (unlikely, but possible). Bullet must be supersonic at target for electronic target to track.

Targets: 500-yards NRA MR-65 sling & MR-65FC F-Class targets. Shot-Marker electronic targets will be used for scoring.

Challenges: Not applicable due to electronic target use.

Setup Time: Check-in and setup will begin at 7 a.m.

Match Start: Firing will commence at 8:00 a.m. barring weather or technical delays.

Match Format:

Match No. 1:

5 sighters, followed by 20 shots for record, scoring Xs, 10s, and 9s ONLY, all other shots are to be scored as a “miss”. Shooting time of 15 minutes with **FOUR wind flags and red safety flag** on the range.

Match No. 2:

No sighters, 20 shots for record, scoring Xs, 10s, and 9s ONLY, all other shots are to, scored as a “miss”. Shooting time of 15 minutes with **TWO wind flags and red safety flag** on the range.

Match No. 3:

Stage 1: String fire of 10 rounds for record, with no sighters. Scoring only Xs, 10s, and 9s all other shots are record as a “miss”. Shooting time of 5 minutes with of one red safety flag at the 500-yard berm. A 4-minute cool off period will be held prior to the start of the next stage. Scores checked upon conclusion of shooting, shooter has no visibility to their scores while shooting.

Stage 2: String fire of 10 rounds for record, with no sighters. Scoring only Xs, 10s and 9s are scored, all others are scored as a “miss”. Shooting time of 5 minutes with **NO** FLAGS. Scores checked upon conclusion of shooting, shooter has no visibility to their scores while shooting.

Match No. 4:

Aggregate of the above matches to decide the high scorer in each of the six categories.

Match No. 5:

Shoot off: The high scorer in each of the divisions (F-Open, F-TR, Match/Any, Service, NRA Non Compliant and Juniors will compete for the OVERALL-WINNER. Shooters will string fire 5 rounds for record: Scoring only Xs, and 10s are scored, all others are scored as a “miss”. Shooting time of 2 minutes with **NO** FLAGS.

Prizes:

Sponsor prizes are awarded via lottery, where all competitors present at the concluding award ceremony have an opportunity to win, with Match Winner, and First, Second, and Third place for each division having increased odds of winning.

Prizes are sponsor donations ranging from cash value discounts, actual products, and apparel.
